Government Admission and counseling system. JOSAA (Joint seat allocation authority)2022

The Ministry of Education [erstwhile Ministry of Human resources Development (MHRD)] has set up The Joint Seat Allocation Authority (JoSAA) 2022 to manage and regulate the joint seat allocation for admission in 114 technical institutions.

Now the question is what is JoSAA supposed to do?

Through the JoSAA counseling process, candidates who qualified in JEE main 2022 or in JEE advance 2022 can partake in counseling to take admission in 23 IITs, 31 NITs, 26 IIITs 29 other GFTIs, and IIEST.

If a candidate is qualified in JEE advance, he/she is eligible to participate in JoSAA counseling.

What is the JoSAA counseling fee?

For general/open category candidates fee is 45,000 and

The fee for SC, ST, and PwD candidates of each category is 20,000.

What is the JoSAA procedure?

Step 1. Registration Step 2. Choice filling of colleges in priority order. Step 3. Freeze, float, slide Let's see the meaning of freeze, float, and slide.

If a candidate chooses to 'Freeze', it means you accepted the allotted seat and your seat will be locked for you.

At this stage, you have to pay:

35,000 if you belong to the General category

15,000 for SC/ST/PWD

If you choose 'Float' it means you accepted the college allotted to you but you want a better discipline in the same college.

If you choose 'Slide' it means you accepted the allotted seat but want a better college and a better discipline.

Note, there are a total of six rounds of counseling in the JoSAA. Candidates can withdraw seats till the 5th round to get back their refund.

Documents required for verification for the JoSAA :

- 1. Class 10+2 mark sheet
- 2. Income + category certificate
- 3. Aadhar
- 4. Tc/ migration + gap year certificate
- 5. Medical certificate

JoSAA registration and choice filling 2022 will start on September 12 and will continue till September 21.
