MCC COUNSELLING

Medical counseling committee (MCC)

The Medical Counseling Committee (MCC) is an organization under the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India, for allotting medical and dental course seats for undergraduate and postgraduate programs in central universities and deemed universities.

Based on the candidate's score in the National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEET), MCC allots seats online to the candidates.

The process of counseling starts after NEET-UG results are declared. Candidates can find counseling schedules, a list of participating institutes, and frequently asked questions on <u>www.mcc.nic.in</u>

Now the question is what is the process of seat allotment by MCC?

There are two processes of seat allotment:

1. All India Quota - which contains 15% seat

Through MCC (All India Quota) counseling

100% seats of AIIMS
100% seats of central university
100% seats of JIMPER (Pondichery)
100% seats of deemed university
And 15% of all Government Medical colleges of India seats are allotted.

2. 85% of the remaining seats and 100% of seats of private colleges/ universities are filled by State Quota.

What are the eligibility criteria to participate in MCC counseling?

Ans - The candidate must be NEET qualified.

Now the question is,

How to participate in NEET counseling 2022?

Following are the process to participate in counseling:

- 1. Registration: go to www.mcc.nic.in (the official website of MCC) and register and for that You will need :
 - NEET UG application and roll number
 - Name and date of birth of the candidate.

Create a password, Then submit and verify with OTP.

Log in using the user id then click on the "Choice Available" option.
 Fill out the available choices for you and choose the colleges of your choice.

What is the basis of the seat allotment?

- Your score in the NEET UG result
- The criteria for reservation
- Choice of colleges filled in the form
- The availability of seats etc

What is the Fee for MCC counseling?

For unreserved category- 1000 (registration fee non-refundable) + 11000 (security fee)

For SC/ST/OBC - 500 (registration fee) + 5000(security fee)

What are the documents required for NEET counseling?

- 1. Allotment letter issued by MCC
- 2. Result/ Rank letter issued by NTA
- 3. Admit card of exam issued by NTA
- 4. Date of Birth certificate
- 5. Class 10th certificate
- 6. Class 12th certificate
- 7. Class 12th
- 8. 8 passport size photograph
- 9. Identity proof

What is the procedure of allotment through MCC counseling?

There are four rounds of counseling:

- 1. Round 1 of All India Quota
- 2. Round 2 of All India Quota and
- 3. Mop-up round of All India Quota &
- 4. Stray Vacancy Rounds for ESIC
- Eligible candidates will be allotted seats in 1st round and they can accept or refuse them.
- If candidates accept the allotted seat then he/ she have to download the allotment form from MCC official site by logging in.
- The admission process starts and ends in two to four days so candidates have to contact the college administration and submit their required documents with the NEET allotment form then admission is granted by DGHS.
- If seats are not allotted in 1st round then a candidate can choose 2nd round and they have to again fill choices from the remaining colleges.
- Those candidates who didn't get selected in 2nd round allotment will automatically go for the MOCK up round.
